Students seeking admission to the Albany State University Darton College of Health Professions Nursing Program must complete this supplemental application for admission *and return it by May 15, 2019 to the Nursing Department Office, Albany State University West Campus, 2400 Gillionville Road, Albany, GA, 31707*

If you wish to receive confirmation that your application has been received - please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your receipt - verification of receipt will not be given by telephone or via email.

ADMISSION TO THE NURSING PROGRAM:

Minimum admission standards include:

1. **Unconditional admission to Albany State University.** (See page 2 checklist)
2. Receipt of this completed application, \$20.00 application fee (money order only made payable to Albany State University) and copy of ATI TEAS® score for the ASN program by the semester deadline. *No applications will be received after the deadline.*
3. Exit all required learning support courses.
4. Have completed all of the general education courses required for the ASU Darton College of Health Professions ADN Nursing program **at the time of submitting this application.**
5. Minimum of 2.8 GPA (**at the time of submitting this application**) based on each attempt of credit hours for general education courses required for the ASU Darton College of Health Professions Nursing program including transferred GPA from other colleges.
6. Must have earned a grade of “C” or better in all nursing core classes.
7. No previous failing grades in any nursing program.
8. Completion of the ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS®) prior to applying to the program.
 - a. Applicants who take the TEAS exam at Albany State University’s West Campus Testing Center may submit a printed copy of their results page with the application and money order.
 - b. Applicants who take the TEAS exam at a testing site other than ASU’s West Campus Testing Center will need to purchase the “TEAS transcript” through ATI Testing’s online store and indicate that they wish to have their scores transferred to Albany State University.
 - c. **Sign up for the TEAS here:** (Limited space available for TEAS testing on Albany West campus, sign up early)

9. Meet core performance standards for admission and progression in the nursing program.
10. Hold current certificate for Paramedic or License for LPN (**attach copy**) with one (1) year of current continuous work experience.
11. **Applicants who do not meet the minimum TEAS score or grade point average are not eligible to apply.**

Admission to the nursing program is competitive, and the number of students is limited by the number of faculty and clinical facilities available. Meeting minimal requirements does not guarantee acceptance.
